

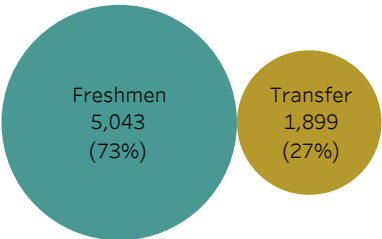

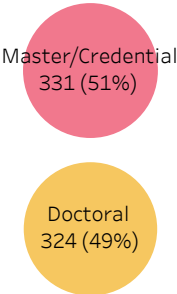

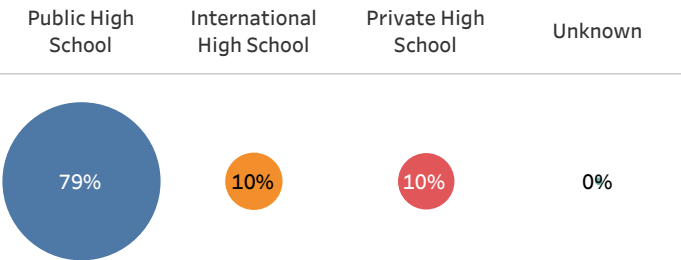
New Undergraduate Enrollment



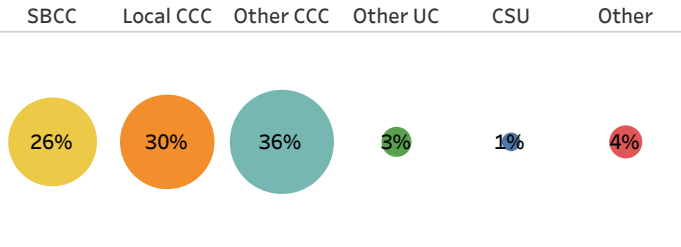
New Graduate Enrollment

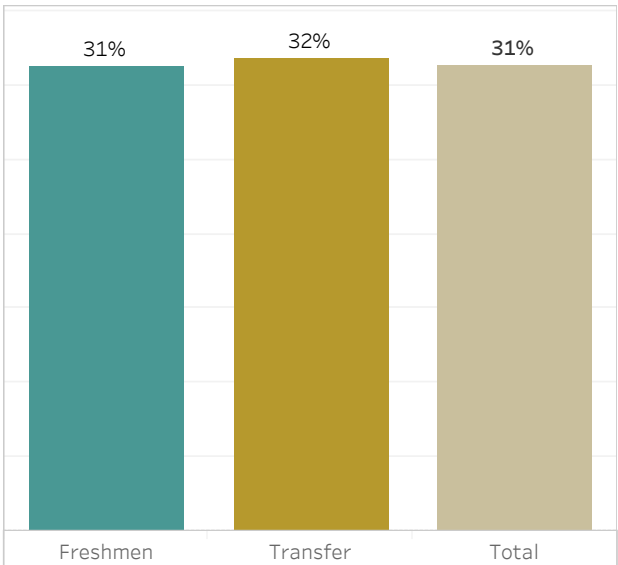

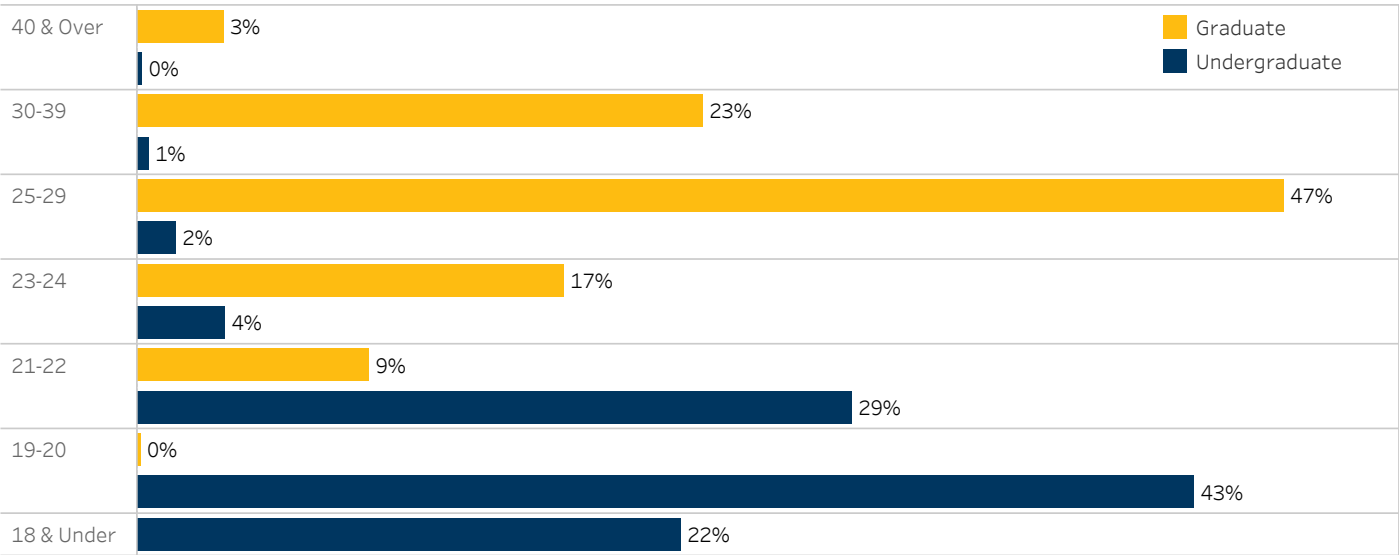

Students



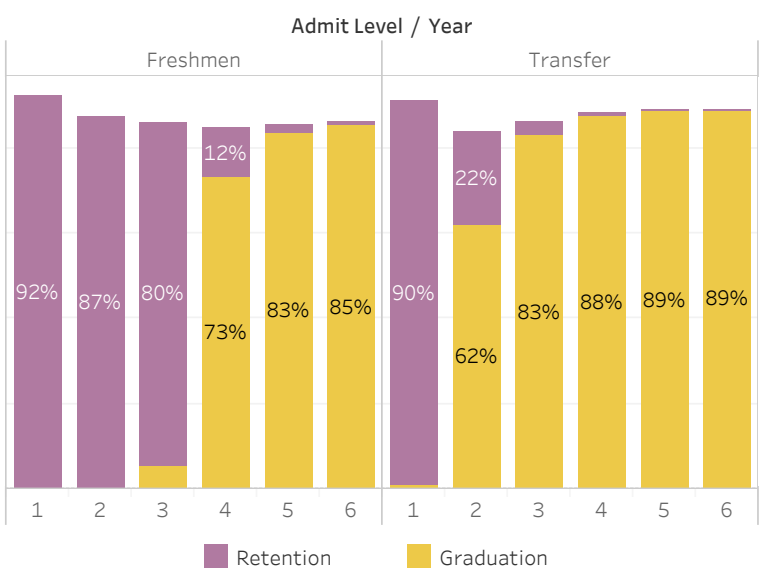
Students Enrolled by Age Group

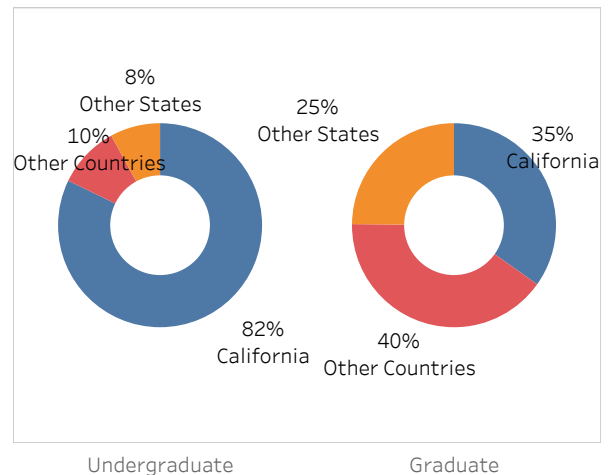

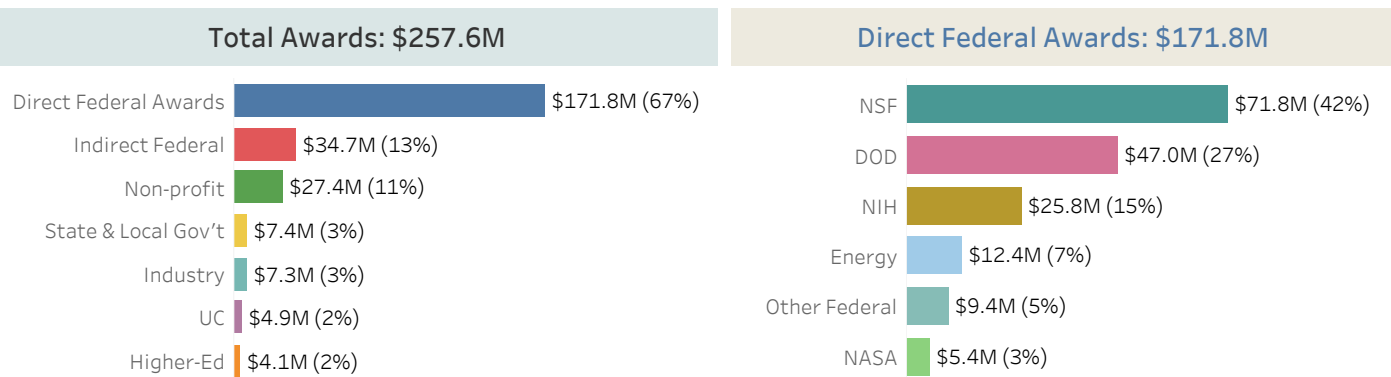

Awards by Sponsor with Breakout of Federal Sponsors, 2022-23



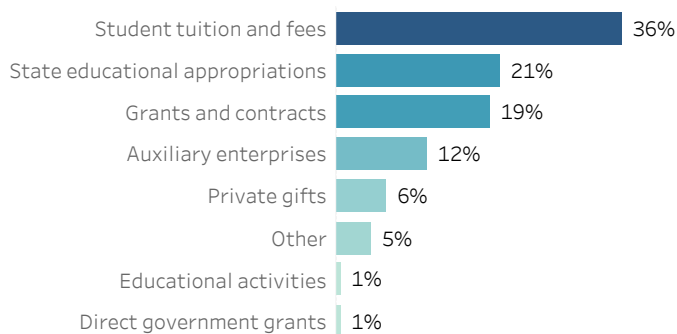

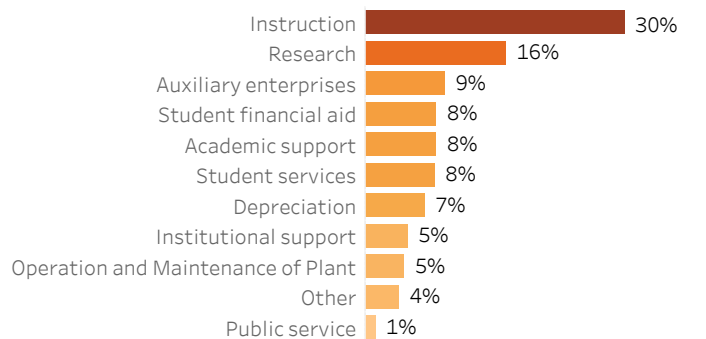
